Add Content

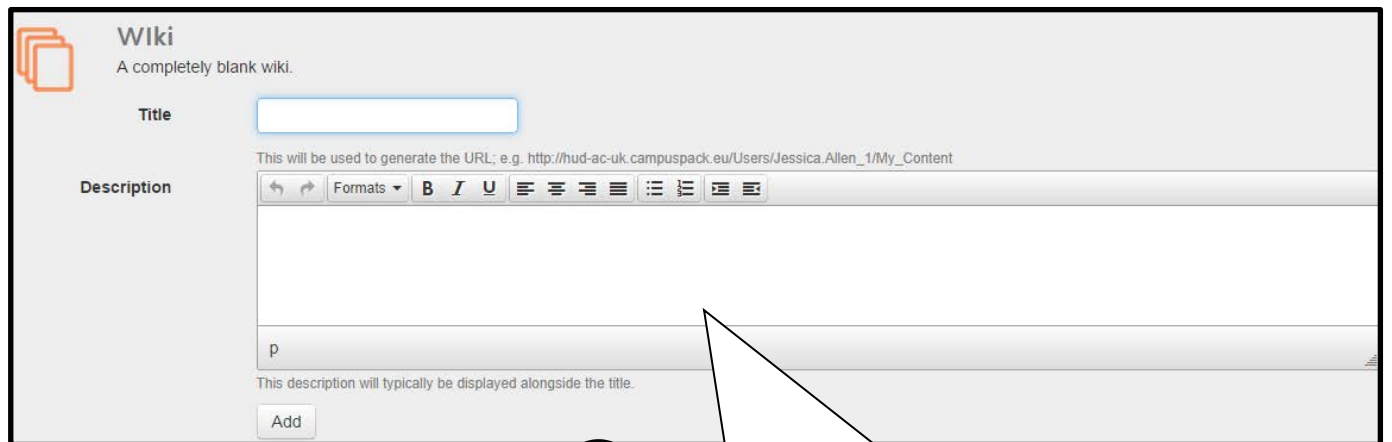

To create an eportfolio choose Add content in the content panel.



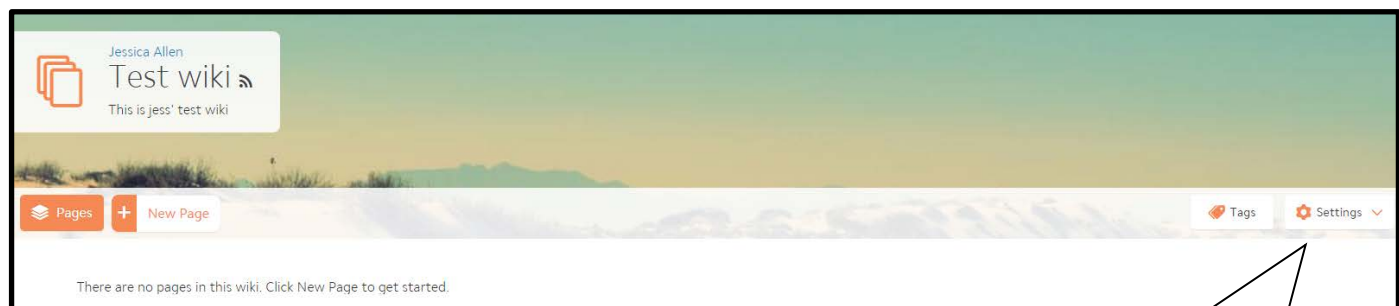

Select Wiki from the list of content.

To change the permission of who can edit and view the wiki, select the settings drop down and then select permission.

8 You can select which users you would like to be viewers and authors by using these tabs.

9 Select 'people' from the column and type in a username in the search box.
If you wish to share your eportfolio with somebody external then you also have the option to send an email.

10 You can set time restrictions for the access of the Blog here, Remember to Save after adjusting your settings

11 Click Add for adding users that you wish to give permissions to.

12 The student and anybody else that they have shared the eportfolio with will be able to see the activity panel on the right which will display when changes have been made to the content.

13 Here is where the students will be able to add pages for their eportfolio. For easy and quick navigation, each page will be listed here after creating them.
