
Small Scale Implementation



Clean and modern interface

More intuitive to use, less clunky, more engaging

Responsive interface – so better experience on mobile devices

Drag and drop of files capability

Most common file types can be viewed in-place

Sophisticated release conditions for content

Personalisation of announcements and some content

In-built eportfolio system

Useful features like video notes, bookmarks, notifications, links to content

Much better analytics tools to view engagement/attainment/progress

Links of specific content to awards/competencies/learning objectives
