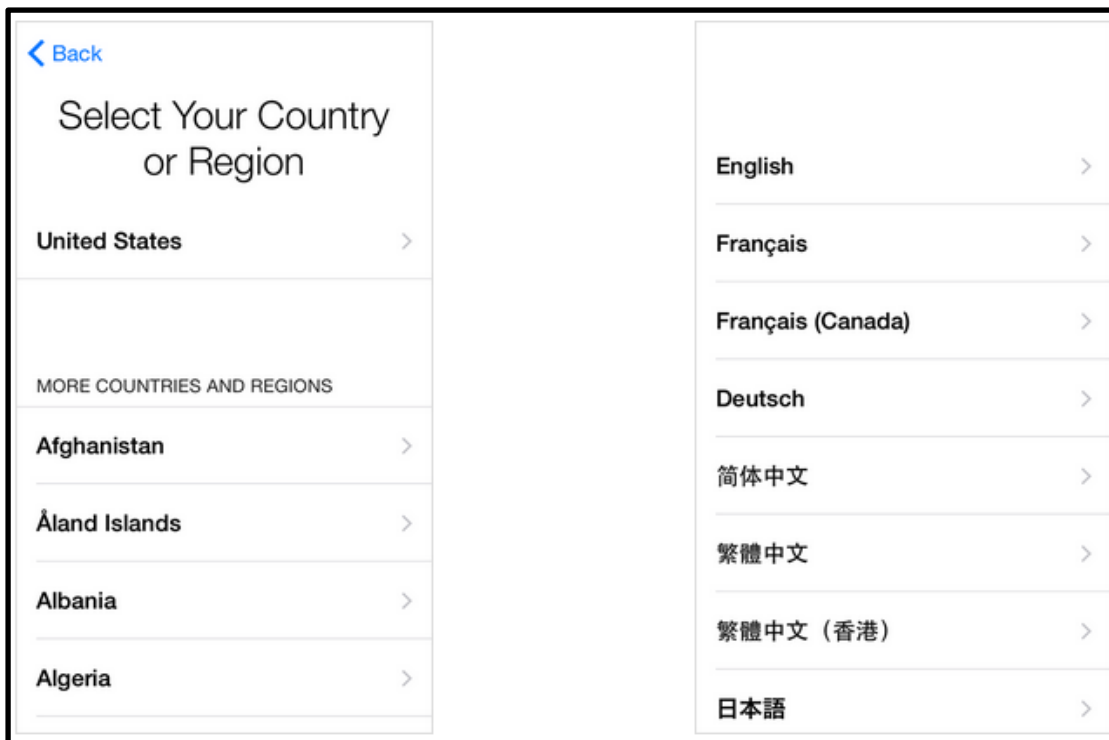


The first screen you will get once you have turned your device on is this. Slide from left to right anywhere on this page to begin.

For those with impairments you can turn on the voice over tool here.

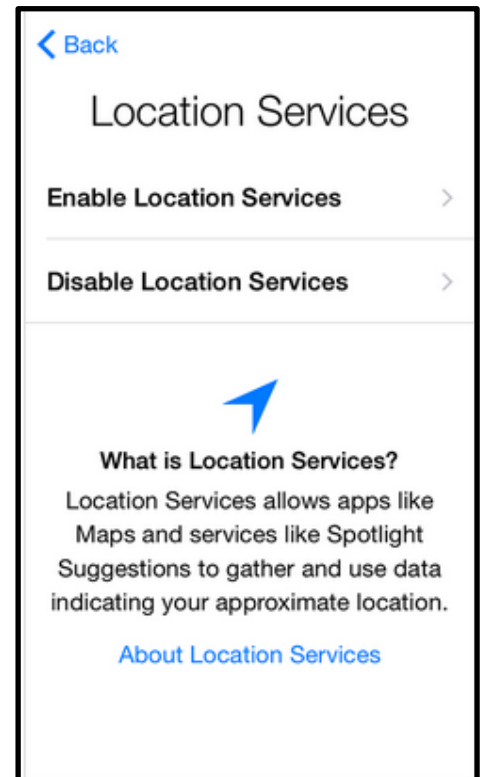


You will then select your region or country.
This will set your device for formatting such as time zones and dates

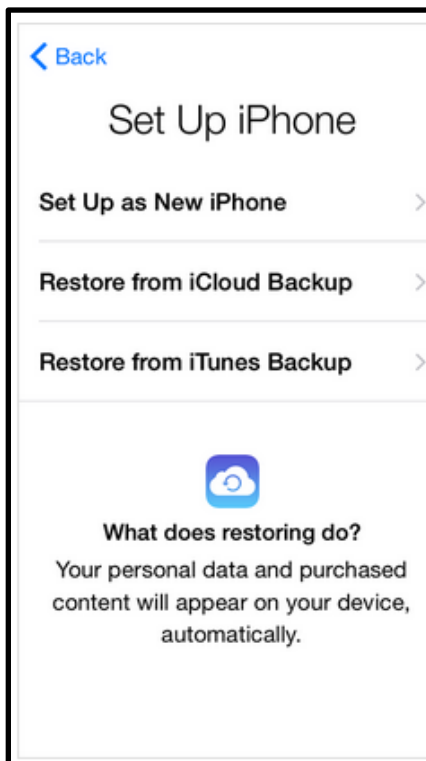


You will then have to select a Wi-Fi network for your device to connect to, simply tap on the right connection and depending on the type of network input the password.

If you are using a device that has an active cell service then you can select "Use Cellular Connection"

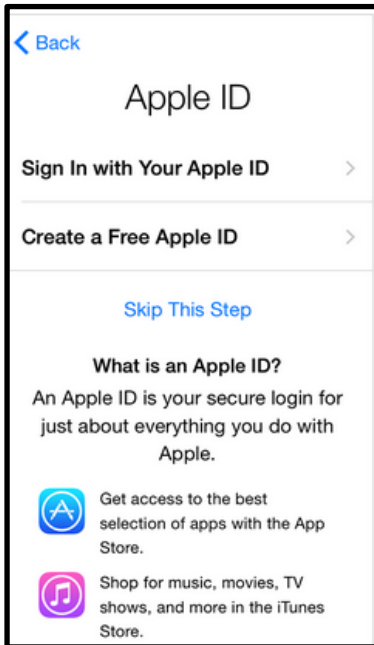


This settings allows certain apps to gather information about your settings.

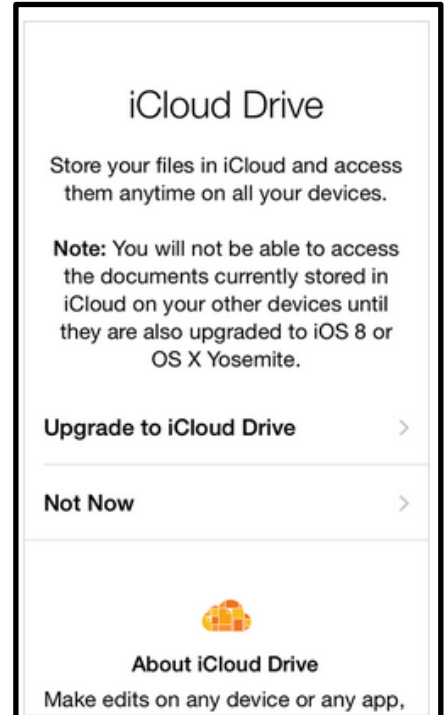


Set up your device as new or restore it from an old device using an online backup

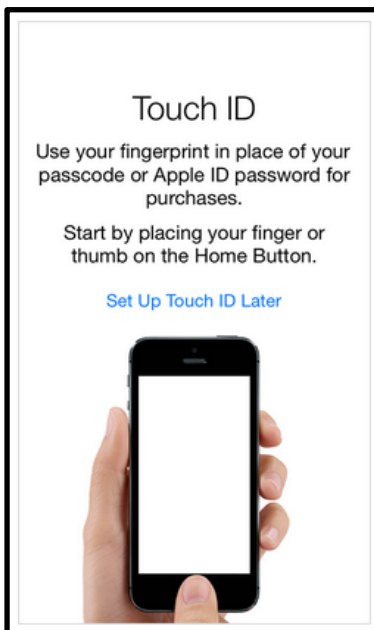
You will then have to agree to some terms and conditions in order to continue.



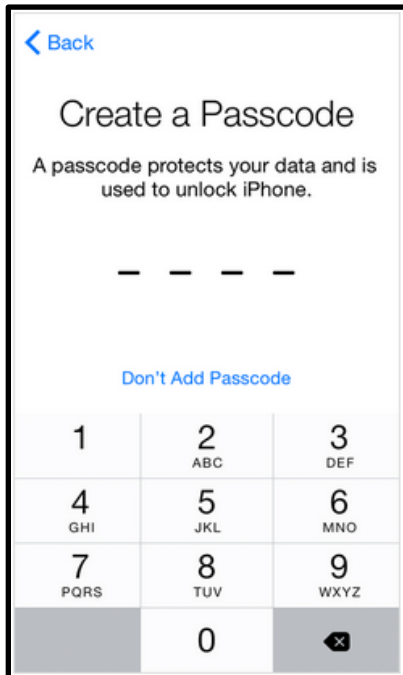
You can then create your apple ID, or you can select skip this step and set this up at a later date. For help on this visit the Apple website.



iCloud Drive enables you to store files and access them at any time, when you upgrade all of your files that are stored on iCloud will be moved onto the iCloud Drive. This operating system specific.



If you own an iPhone 5s or later, an iPad Air 2 or later or an iPad mini 3 or later you can set up Touch ID, this is when you can use your finger print to unlock your device, make purchases and even sign into some accounts.

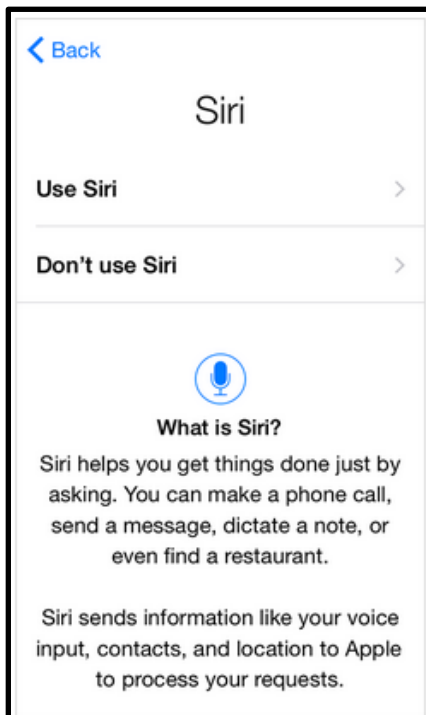


To protect the data on your device you can set up a password, if you do not want to use one tap on "Don't Add Password"

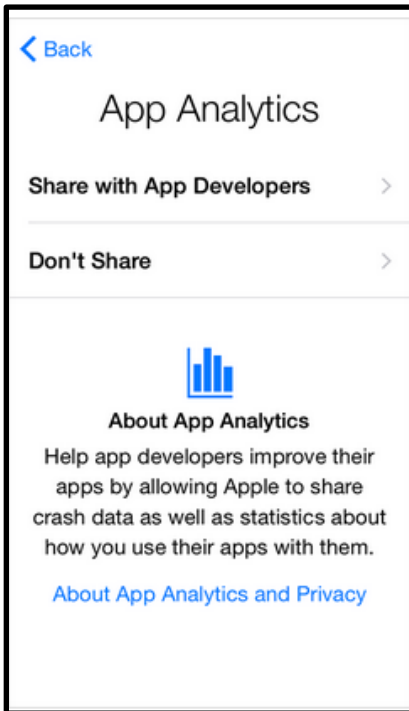
For added security if you type in a commonly used password you will be asked to input a more secure one in.



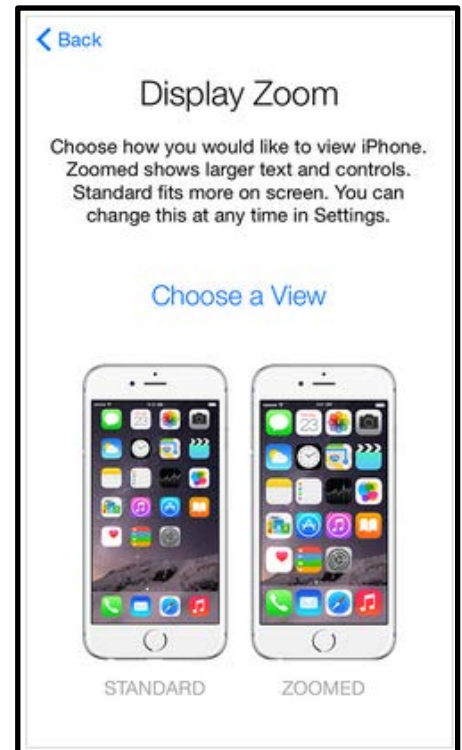
This option keeps your safari usernames and passwords, credit card information and WI-FI network information up to date across all of your approved devices.



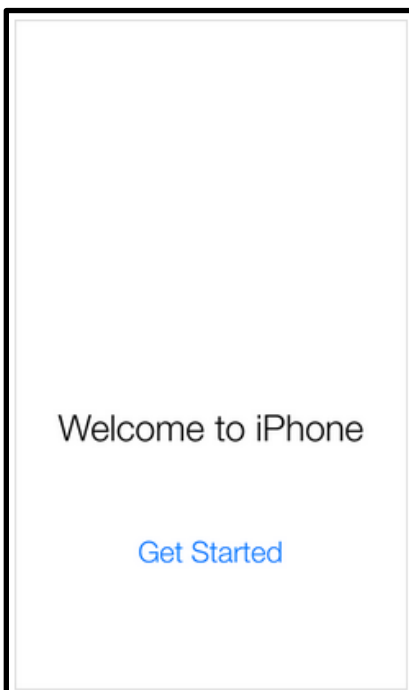
Siri enables you use your voice to carry out a number of tasks such as search the web, sent text messages and so on.
