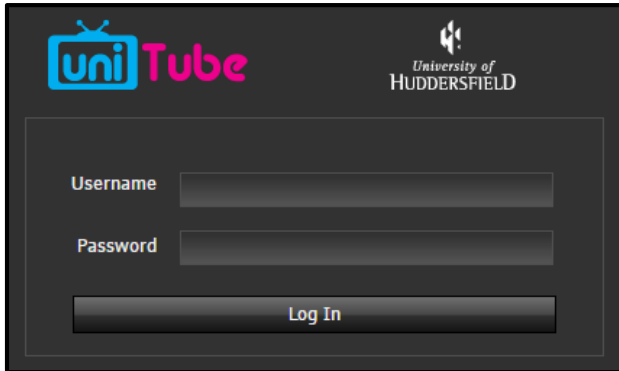


This guide covers the process for adding a UniTube video to MyReading. The how to guide includes accessing and searching UniTube, and how to embed a video in a reading list.



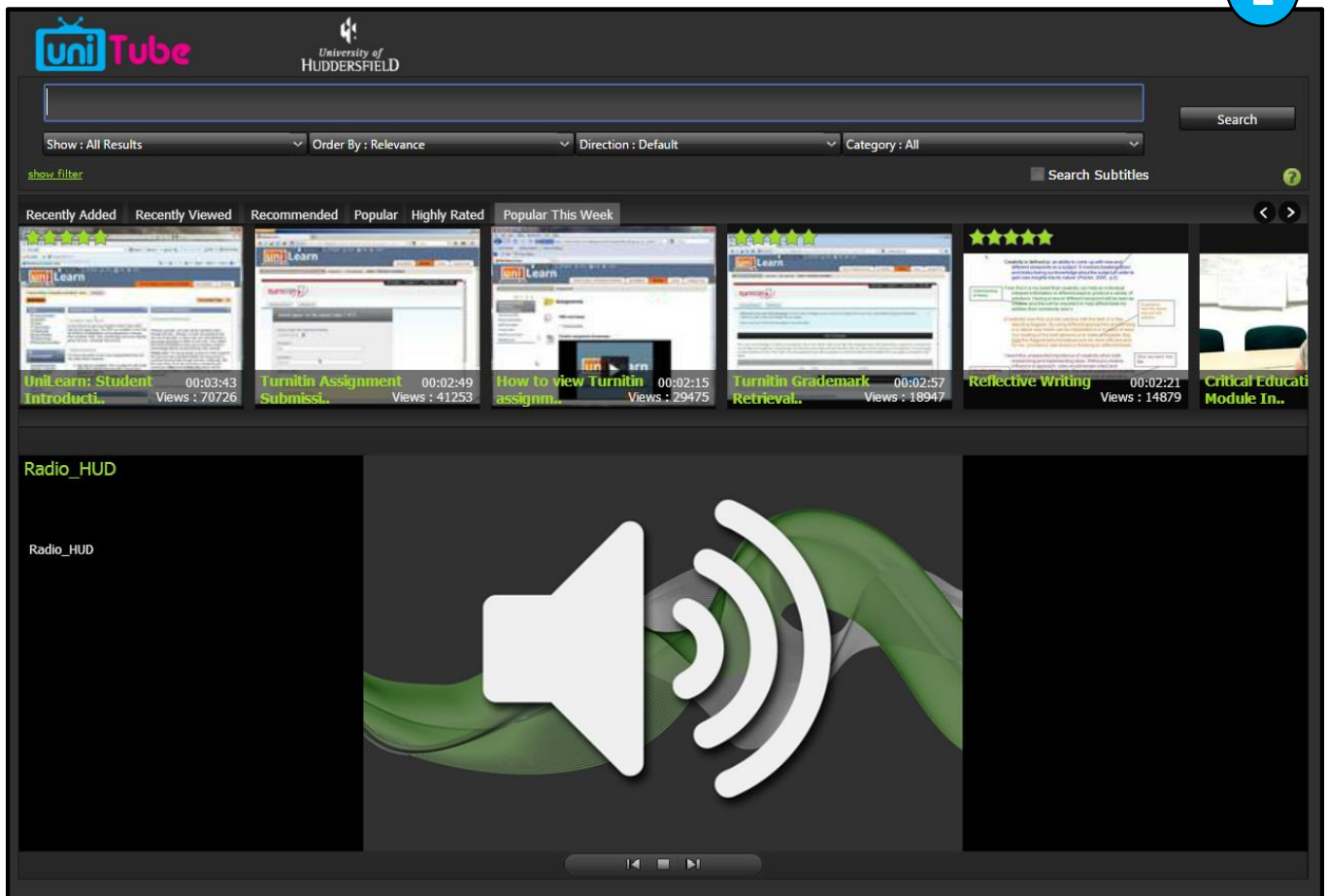
Go to <https://unitube.hud.ac.uk/> to access videos on UniTube.

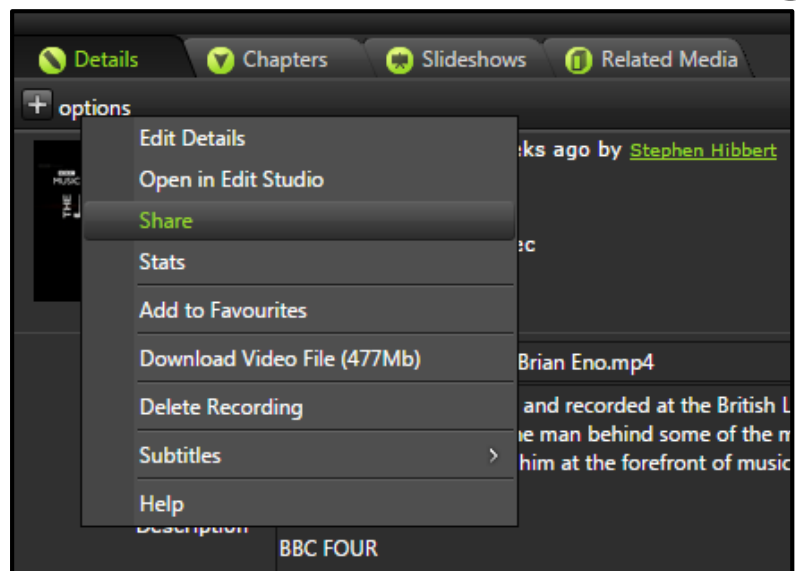
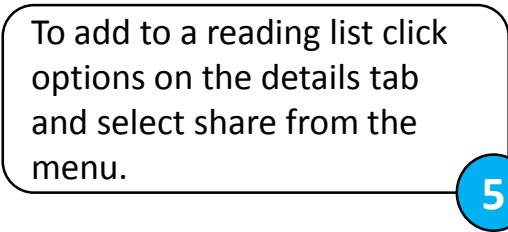
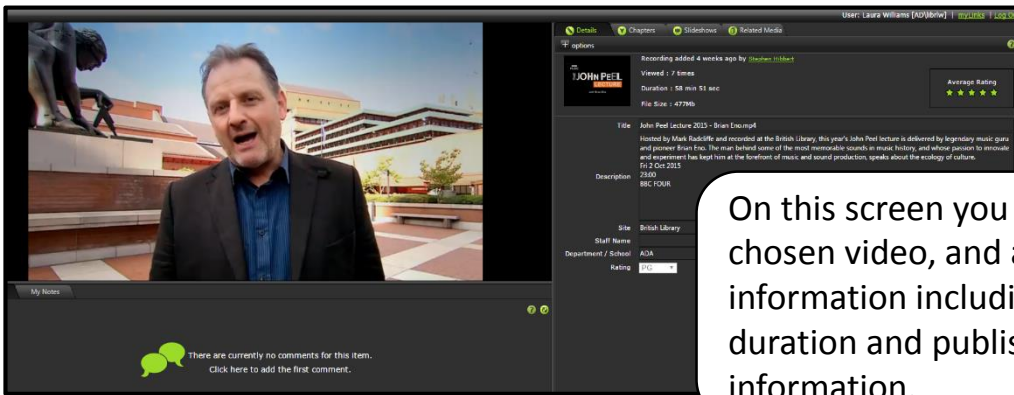
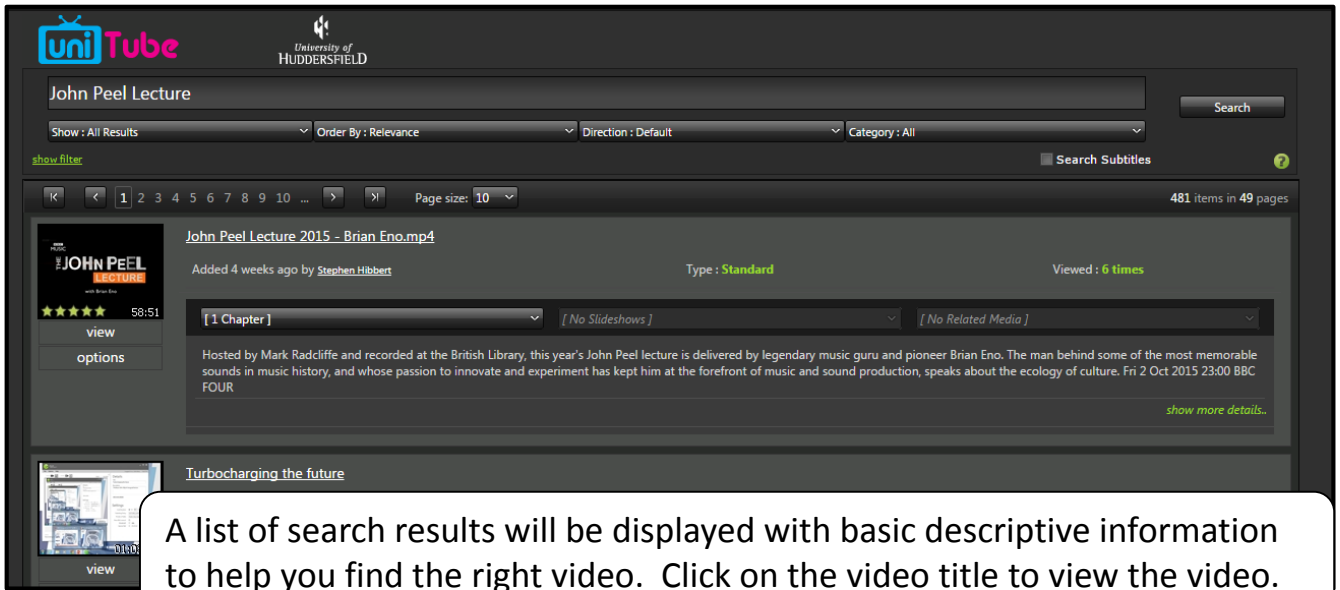
Log in using your university username and password.

Search for videos using the search box at the top of the screen or browse through recently viewed videos. Filters can be used to narrow search results.

The share box contains information needed to add the video to a reading list.

You will need the web link for recording URL code to link to the video on MyReading. This will allow students to click through from MyReading to the video in UniTube.

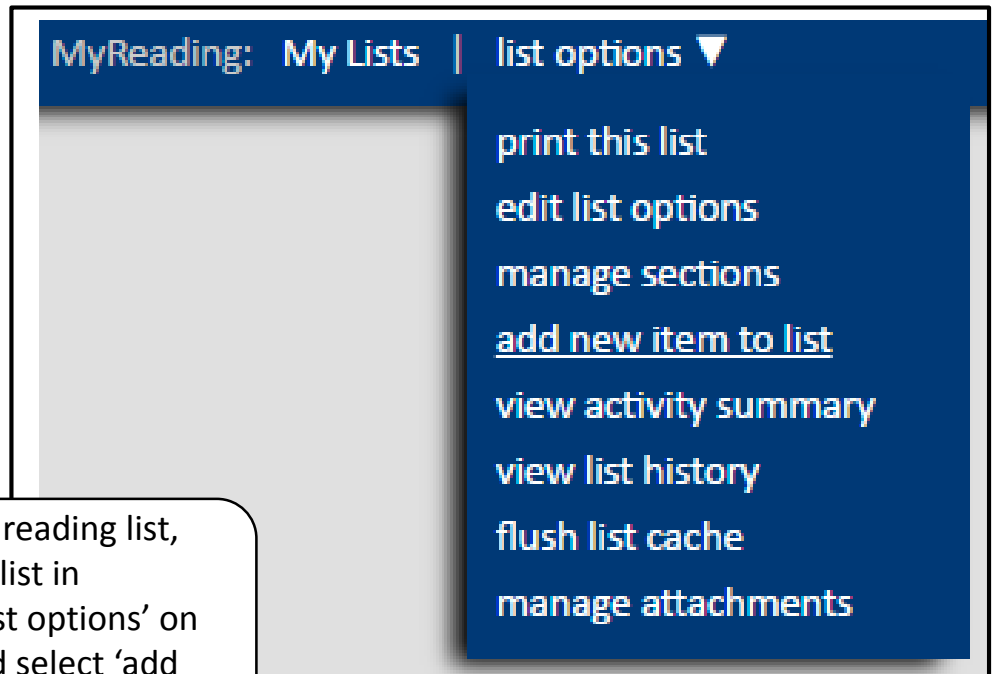
You will need the embed code to add the video in your reading list as an embedded video. This will allow students to watch the video in MyReading.

Next we need to add this video to MyReading. To do this, first open a new tab or window in your internet browser then open your reading list in MyReading.

Keep UniTube open as you will need to go back to the share options for the video to copy and paste the web link and embed code.

To add the video to a reading list, first go to the reading list in MyReading. Go to 'list options' on the top menu bar and select 'add new item to list'

To add a UniTube video to MyReading you need to add the reference manually.

The title of the video must be added to the title box. You will need to add the recording URL code (see step 6). If you want to embed the video, copy and paste the embed code in the embed code box (see step 7).
