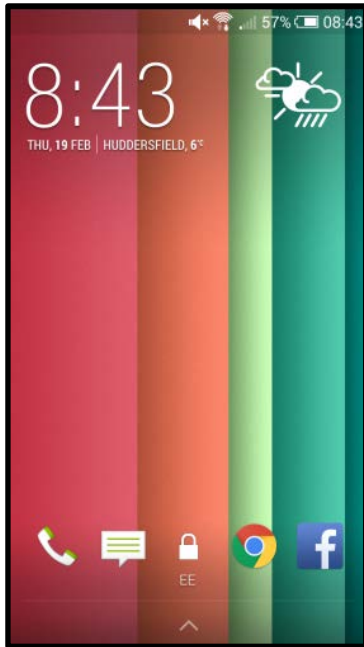
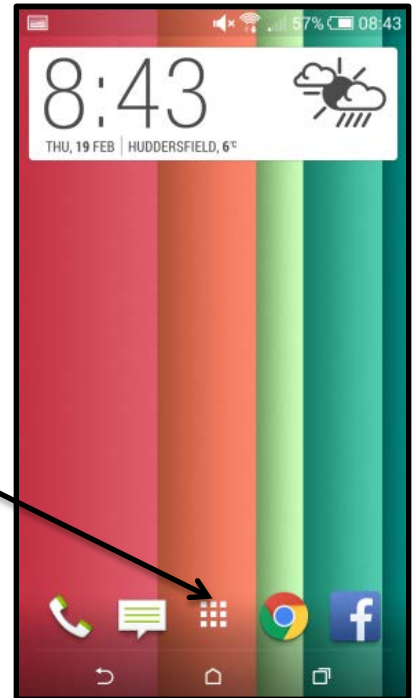


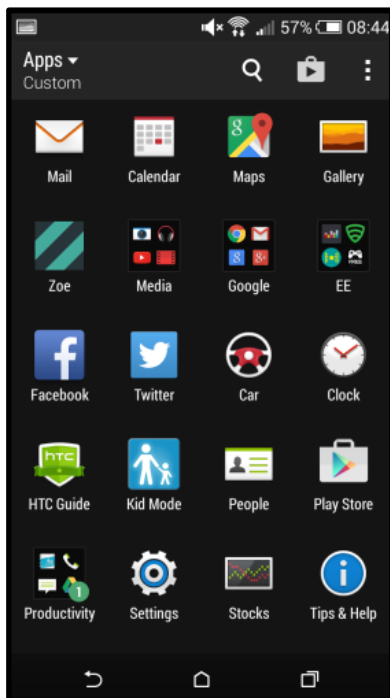
Please Note: There are a large amount of different versions of Android, they generally look similar but some Features may be different to what you are using. To do this I used a HTC MINI ONE.



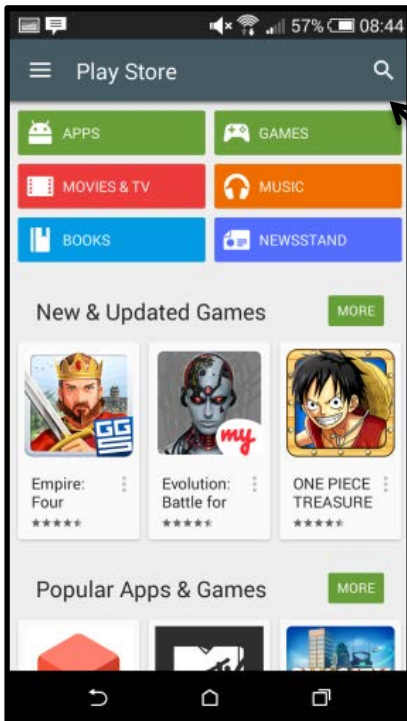
You will firstly need to unlock your phone, simply use you fingers to slide the arrow up at the bottom. If you have set up a security password you will then be asked to put it in.



Once unlock you will see a screen similar to this one here, so locate the app store tap the dotted square at the bottom of the screen.

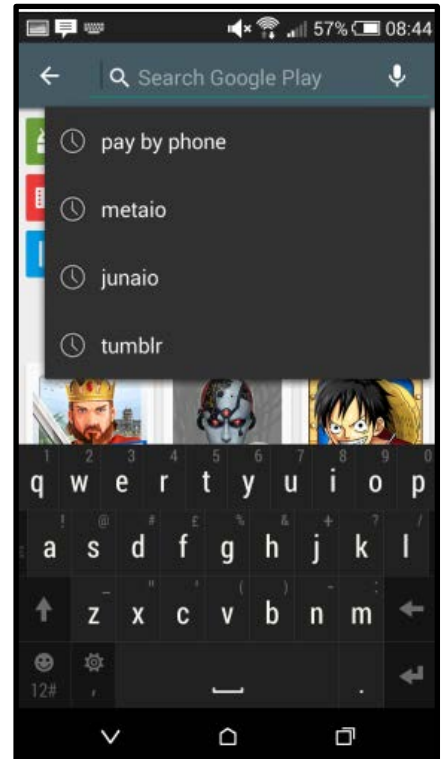


You will then be taken to the menu, tap the play store icon. This looks like a shopping bag with a play symbol on it.

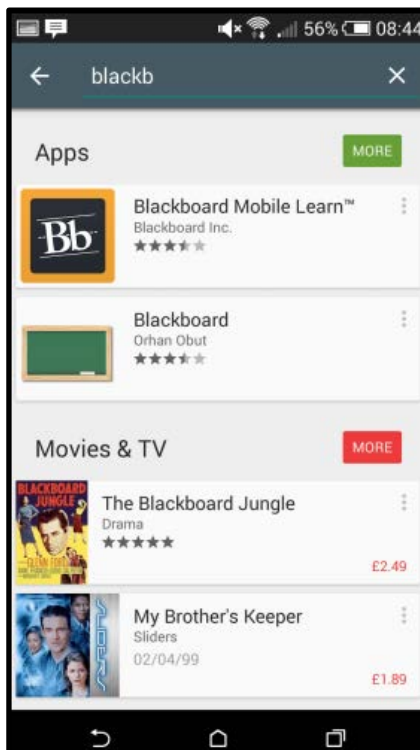


This is the play store home page, you can view which apps you have downloaded by selecting the six coloured buttons at the top, this will show you the apps you have downloaded separated by type.

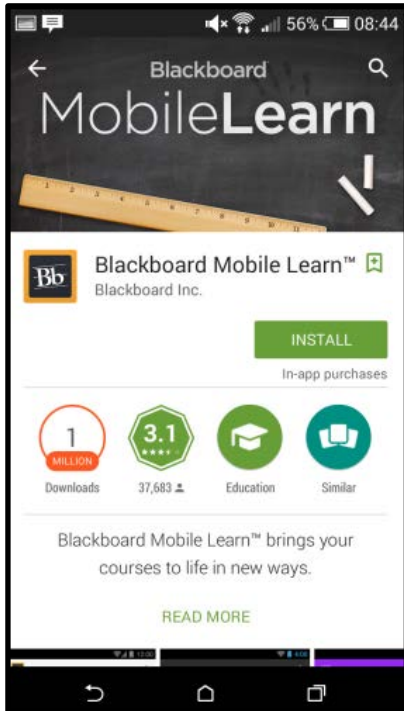
Use the search icon in the top right to search for your app.



Once the search icon is selected a keyboard will appear and a small list of the last apps you downloaded. Simply start typing.

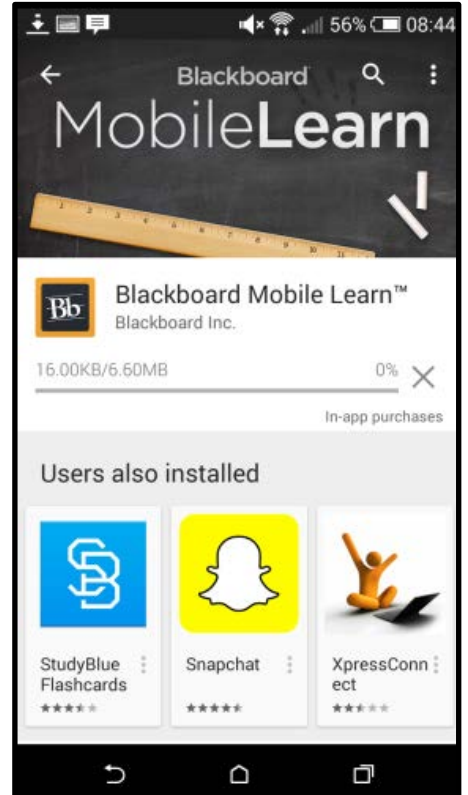


Keep typing until the app you are looking for appears in the suggestion list below the search bar, once it is there simply select it and you will be taken straight to it.

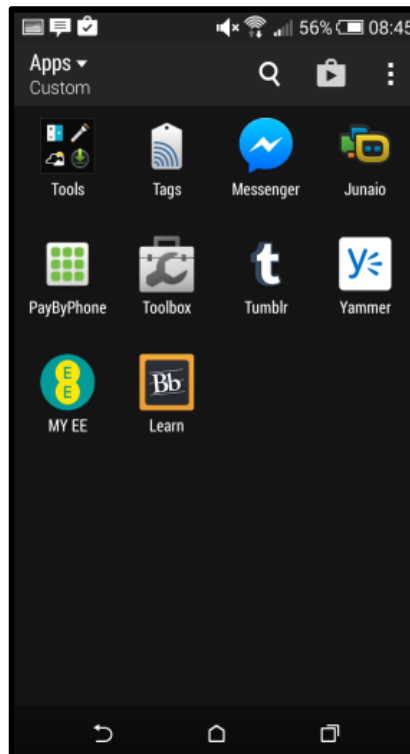


Once you select the app you want from the search results list you will be taken into the specifications and details of the app. You can make sure that you will be able to install the app successfully.

To start tap on the Install button



You can see that the installation process has begun by the progress bar.



Once your app has downloaded it will be on your device in two places, on the home page and on the menu. I usually delete the one on the home page by pressing and holding and then flicking it towards the top of the page.
