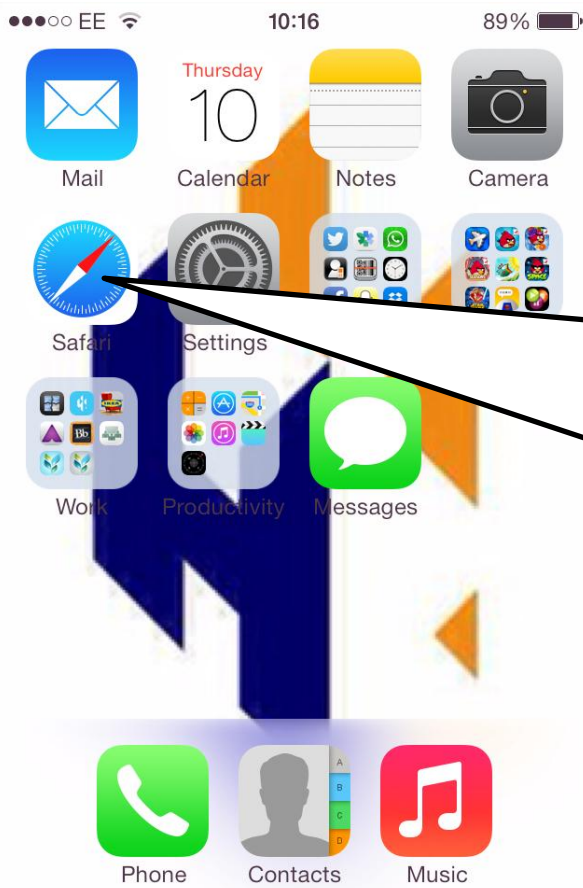
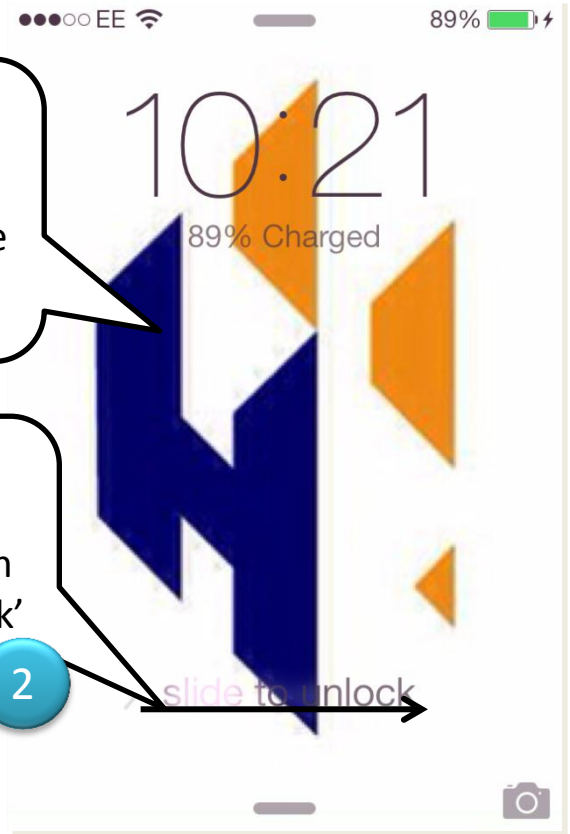
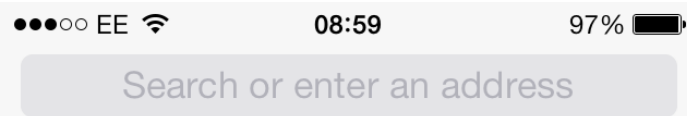


1 This is your lock screen. You will find that your background image will be different. Here you will find Basic information like the time, signal, Wi-Fi connectivity and the battery status (If charging it will state the percentage charged).

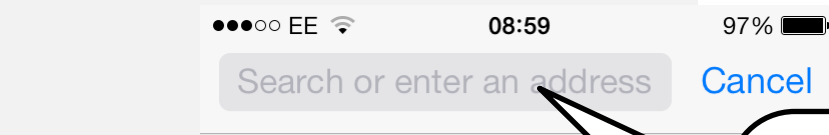
To unlock your device; you must first press either the power button or home button on your device. This brings up your home screen as seen to the right, swipe the 'Slide to unlock' section on your screen from left to right.



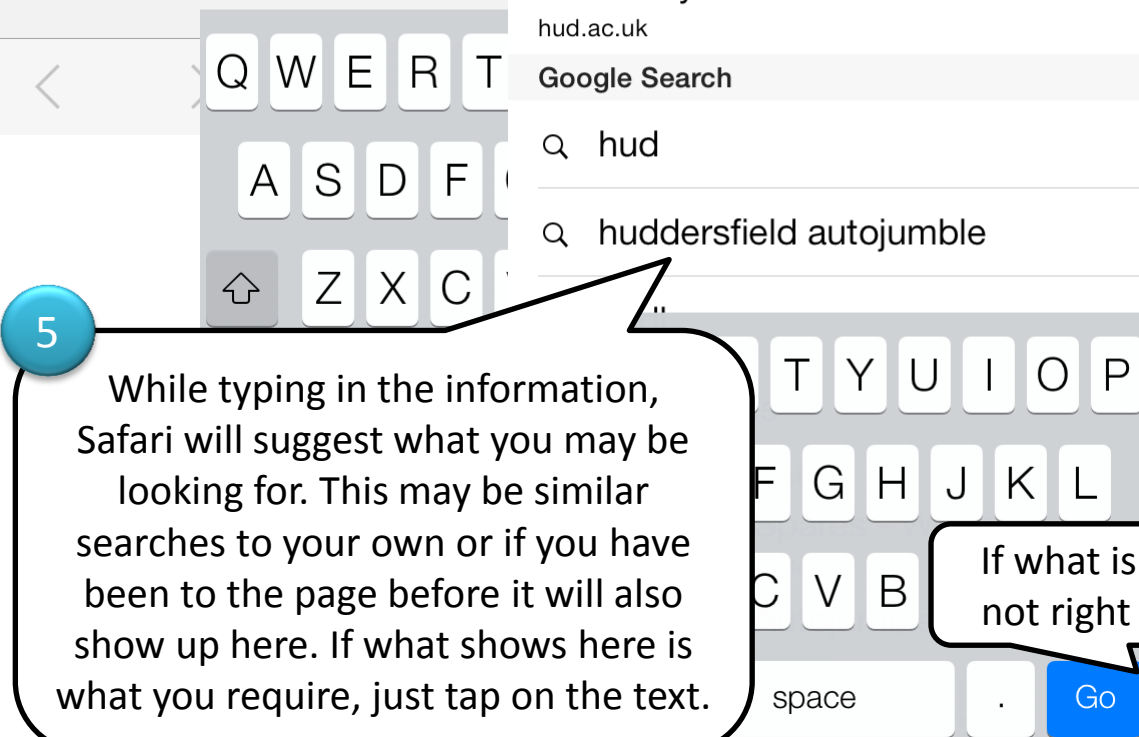
The screen you are brought to lists all of your available apps and resources. You may have created folders to hold a group of apps or you may need to swipe the screen from right to left, which will show you your further pages. In this case, locate your 'Safari' browser and tap it once.

You will first be brought to this screen, this lists all of your favourites that you have saved. Here we can see the default favourites.

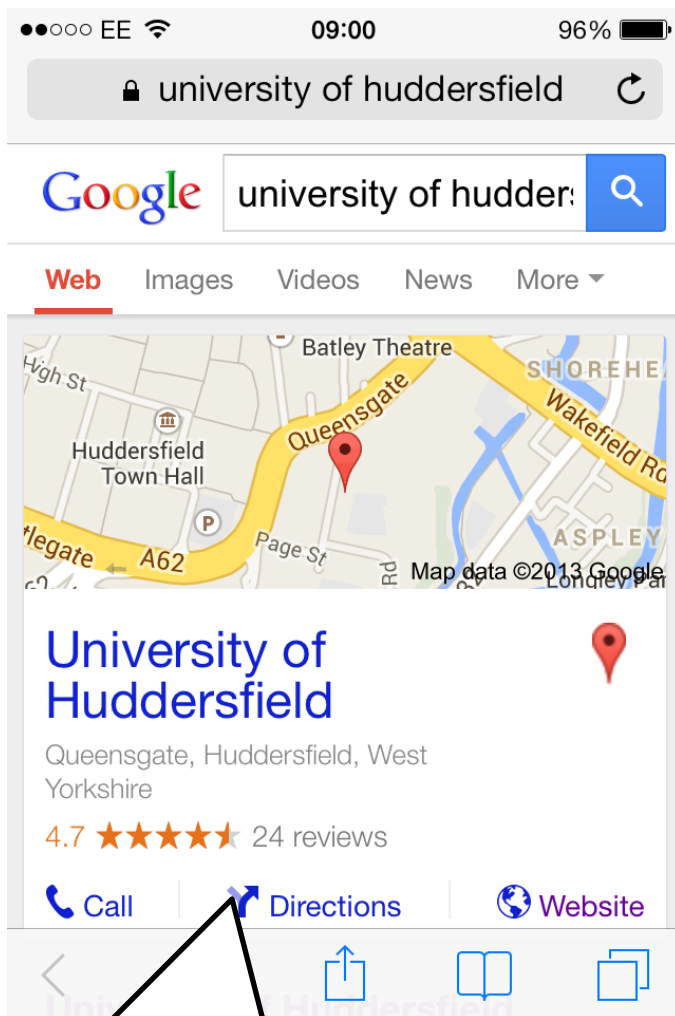

To either search or go to an address tap on the top grey bar currently saying 'Search or enter an address'. Then use the keyboard that pops up to enter what you want to search or the webpage you want to go to.

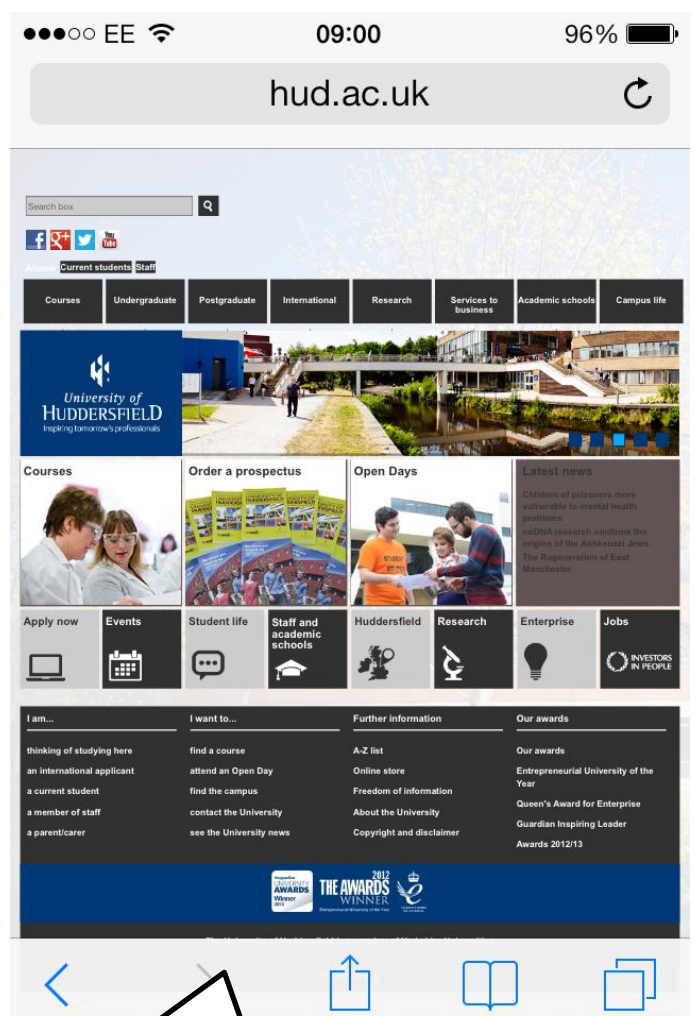

While typing in the information, Safari will suggest what you may be looking for. This may be similar searches to your own or if you have been to the page before it will also show up here. If what shows here is what you require, just tap on the text.

If what is suggested is not right just tap 'Go'.

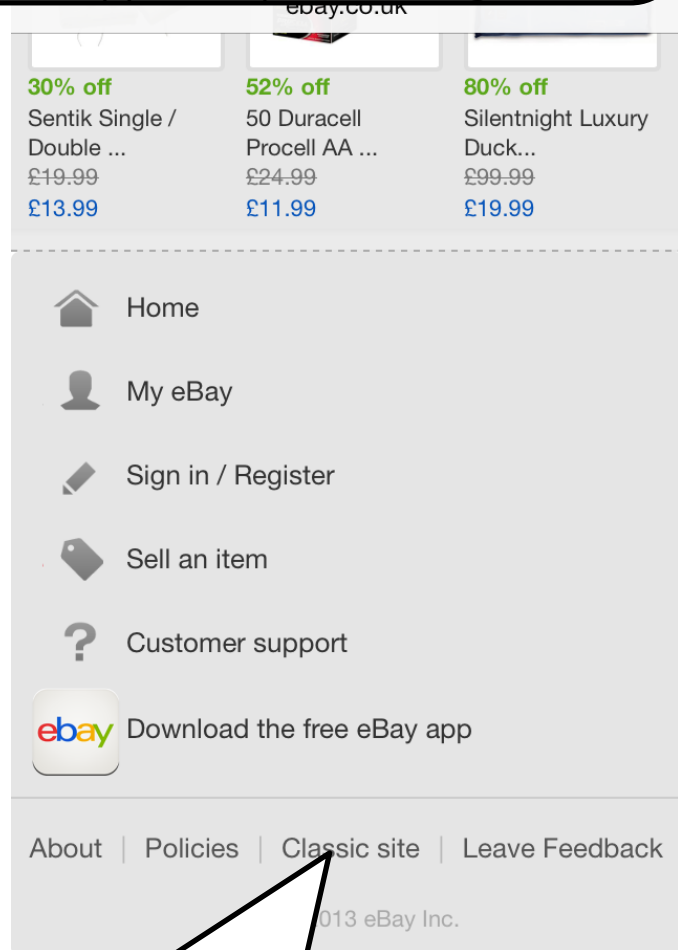
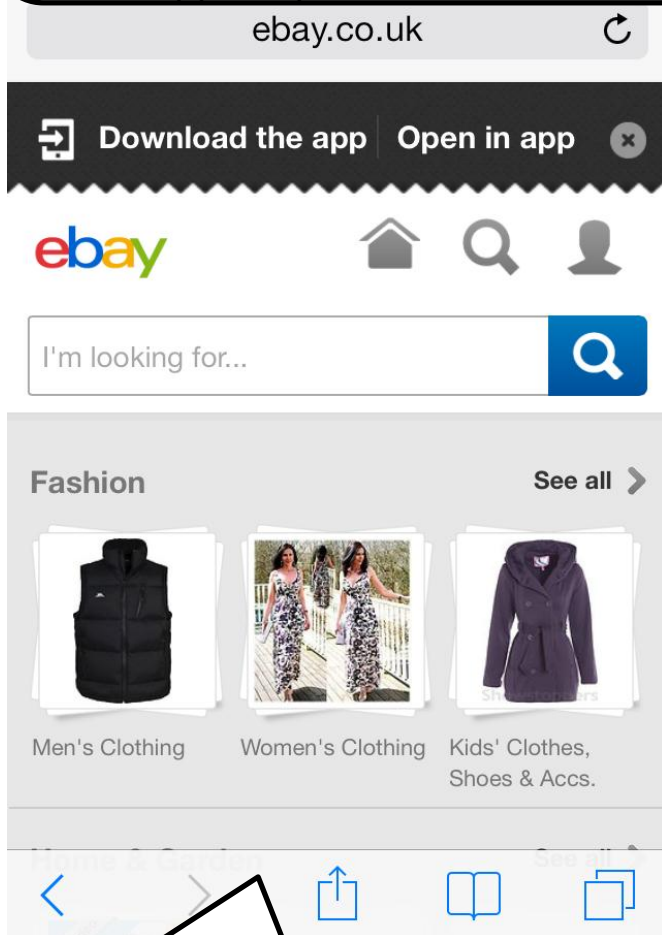


Making a search, will lead you to this page, similar to any other browser. However it does feature one or two extra options, such as if you search for a place of interest it will give you Google maps options. You can edit the search, by clicking on the search bar in Google or by using the grey bar again.



Typing a web address should take you directly to the page. Some pages will appear as they would on a computer, others may have mobile websites specifically designed for use on mobile devices. If you enter an incorrect web address, Safari will treat this as a search and will take you into Google, just like a normal search.

Tap on the screen to select something on a webpage. Double tap to zoom in on an area. Slide your finger over the screen to move the webpage around. You can also place 2 fingers on the screen at the same time, slide away from each other to zoom in and towards each other to zoom out. If you wish to save an image tap and hold down on the image, until a pop up of options appear, you can then 'save image', 'copy' and open the image.



Some webpages, as mentioned will appear differently in comparison to how it will appear on a computer.

They may also prompt you to download an app, for that webpage, meaning information you enter will be stored better in the app plus have better functionality on your device.

These webpages may not have all the features that you would normally expect, but usually they will have a link similar to 'Classic site'. This will load up the normal webpage.

Use these two arrows to go backwards and forwards on your webpages. You can also swipe the screen from left to right to go back or right to left to go forwards.

Use this icon to manage your bookmarks and favourites. This can also be used to access your history if you wish to find a webpage you have visited recently. This will be organised into days, weeks and months.

Use this icon to send and share the webpage or search with others, providing you with options like 'Mail' and 'Facebook'. With this you can add a little more information like a description to explain to others. This is also used to create 'Bookmarks' quickly or even add an instant link from your home screen.

Tapping this icon will pan out from the webpage, giving you the ability to manage your webpages, quickly switch between them and open new tabs. (As seen below)

Tapping 'Private' will turn on private browsing, this will mean that no history or data is stored.

If you wish to change webpages, tap on the one you want. If you want to close a webpage either drag it off screen from right to left or click the 'X' in the top left corner of the page.

Tap done, to pan back into your selected web page.

Tapping this plus icon will open a new page.
