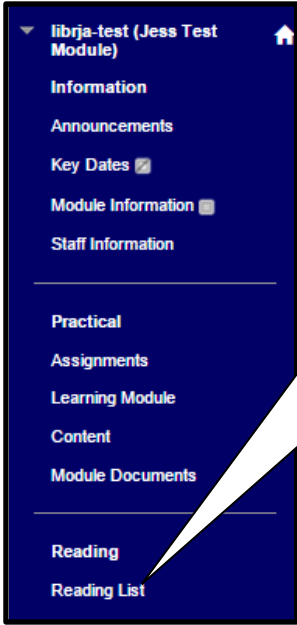


MyReading – Overview and Accessing

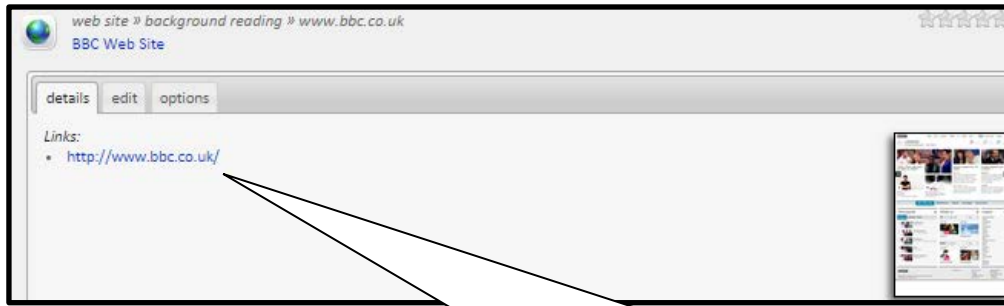
